Asking people to do something **REQUEST**

- Will you help me to wash the car?

Promises

- I promise I won't go without you.

Resolutions **THREAT**

- I will marry John. (even though my parents don't want me to)

Snap decisions **ON THE SPOT DECISION**

- I like the dress in the shop window. I'll buy it.

Predictions

- It will rain in London, tomorrow morning.

Inevitable

- Harry is 26. He will be 27 next year in August.

Volunteering to do something **OFFER**

- Mary hasn't arrived yet so I'll cook dinner.

In sentences with verbs of opinion

- I think it will rain.
- I don't believe he will come.
- I doubt she will tell the truth.

First conditional

- If you don't leave immediately
I will call the police.
